TREASURER'S REPORT

Our chequing account stands at \$10542.81. At the Summer Sale we brought in \$1100 from table rentals, \$210 from the raffle, and \$170 from membership dues and the room rental for the day was \$260.

Previously, VanDusen had provided us with one free day of rent per year, which would also be the most expensive day. This policy is no longer in effect, meaning that we had roughly \$700 more in costs for the previous fiscal year and operated at a deficit of \$900 rather than \$200.

Brief tips for Fall Orchid Care – Adapted from the American Orchid Society (AOS) and other sources – Wayne Riggs:

Just as spring brings a seasonal transition welcoming new growth, fall also represents a time for change. Orchid growers should be adjusting for slowing growth and flowering over the winter months. Unless a plant is in trouble you should delay repotting until the days once again begin to lengthen in spring.

For many orchids the shortening days of fall and winter stimulate the development of bud sheaths and flowering. Commonly, phalaenopsis, cymbidiums and various hybrids and species begin to show developing inflorescences at this time of year. Watch for this development and begin to stake spikes as appropriate for plant type.

If you have had some of your orchids outside for the summer, it is the time to move many of the more tender types indoors. Be sure to inspect them for unwelcome pests – a spray with horticultural oil, 1 mL in 100 ml water, or an insecticidal soap may be a good idea. Tidy and disinfect your growing area(s) with diluted bleach (1:10) in water or use a bactericide/fungicide such as Physan. Your orchids will also enjoy supplemental light – there are many types of fluorescent and LED lights fixtures available that may suit your needs.

Adjust the frequency of watering depending on your growing environment. Consider the drying effect of supplemental heat and the overall humidity of your growing space. Expert growers such as our own Eugene Banziger and Fred Clarke fertilize with each watering. If using city/municipal water, Fred recommends a 'balanced' fertilizer such as 15-15-15 or 20-20-20 at a rate of ¼ teaspoon per gallon every watering. Also recommended is the addition of Cal-Mag fertilizer at ¼ teaspoon per gallon every watering. Enjoy the beautiful orchid flowers that this season brings.
