Annual Show and Sale


Unfortunately we had to cancel our annual show and sale, but the show committee is working on another event later in the year.







Den. cuthbertsonii pink x purple and white. Have had this plant for about 5 years. Continues to get larger each year. Flowers are very long lasting (6-8 months). Growing in a terrarium under LED light in a mix of sphagnum moss and perlite. I use two clay pots - a small one for the plant and a second over this to keep the roots cooler.

Paph. Hung Shen Pink (Paph. moquetteanum x Paph. emersonii). Very large flower with two more buds to follow. Paph. moquetteanum is a sequential bloomer, emersonii is a compact grower. Both traits are present in this cross. Flowers tend to be long lasting. Growing in the greenhouse in Orchiata bark, perlite and charcoal mix.





Den. Aussie's Hi-Lo Yellow Red. I have had this plant for just over 2 years. It is a very reliable bloomer with flowers lasting up to 6 months. Growing in terrarium under LED light in a mix of sphagnum moss and perlite. I use two clay pots - a small one for the plant and a second over this to keep the roots cooler.

C. Love Knot (C. sincorana x C. walkeriana). Have had in my collection for many years. Flowers 2-3 times a year. Blooms are long lasting and fragrant. Growing in greenhouse in Orchiata bark, perlite and charcoal mix.
