
Ecuagenera Pop Up Sale and Pre-Orders

About Dick Doorschot and the Orchid Relay

Dick Doorschot was born and lived in the Netherlands until 1967, when he immigrated to Canada with his family, settling in Nelson and working for the CPR. In spite of being the lone orchid enthusiast in town, he continued his hobby. With no one to take it over, he had to abandon most of his collection when he moved to Trail. There, again working for the CPR, he started up again with a new greenhouse. Growing mainly genera in the Cattleya alliance, he developed an impressive collection as "the only orchid grower in Trail." His wife, Jean, says "orchids were his whole life". Now 86, he is moving to Victoria and will not include any orchids in his journey. His family friend in Trail helped save his collection from the Trail dump by sending out a message to VOS. Thus began an orchid relay of VOS members and a charitable Facebook Marketplace follower.

We invite VOS and other orchid lovers to carry on Dick's devotion to his life's work by purchasing some of the outstanding mature hybrids from his collection at the sale on <u>October 1 and 2.</u> See you there!






