

She was a woman of many talents. A geologist specializing in diamonds, she travelled frequently to Canada's True North. She was an accomplished photographer. And in the last 10 years of her life, she became passionate about orchids, and was successful with her diverse collection. She caught the orchid bug after seeing



a VOS orchid display at Bloedel Conservatory and conversing about orchid culture with a VOS member. In the film "It's a Wonderful Life", the guardian angel says "No man is a failure who has friends." Jennifer, you were highly successful, and you leave behind many friends.

#### Order Deadline for Appendix II Species and Hybrids

**April 28** – Last day for Appendix II species and hybrid orders. *All Appendix II pre-orders are final after this date.* 

You are welcome to submit multiple orders during the available time frame. An 18% surcharge will be applied to each order to cover permit, inspections, customs and transportation fees. As per plant regulations, all orchids will arrive bare root with packing moss around the root system. Orchids ordered In-Spike cannot be guaranteed and may arrive Not In-Spike. Only orchids designated **Approved For Export (CITES)** will be eligible for purchase. Supplies are not eligible for export and any orders placed for supplies will be canceled.






