





Thank you to all VOS members who generously provided flowering orchids for our display in the Fraser Valley Show held in Langley, October 28-30, 2016.


Ingrid Pike coordinated the collection of plants, and she, along with Mary Sang, organized them into a very lovely display for the show—see representative photos.





My Growing Obsession

I have always loved houseplants. In fact, when I moved south after a four-year job posting in Yellowknife, NWT, I had to find homes for the 100+ plants that I had in my apartment there. Of course, I was afraid to try growing orchids because they were so exotic and I had heard (as we all have) that they are hard to grow. That didn't stop me from admiring them.

My interest in orchids was heightened when I took a trip to Western Australia one September, which is wildflower season. We did a lot of hiking and the hikes quickly turned into native orchid hunting missions.

I was afraid to try growing orchids because I had heard that they are hard to grow.

There were many amazing and wonderful orchids to find growing in some rather inhospitable environments, on rocks and gravelly beaches or along roadsides. Thankfully, I found a guidebook to help me identify the orchids we saw. They were amazing, but not plants I ever considered being able to grow.

A few years later, on a trip to Malaysia, we visited the Kuala Lumpur Orchid Park. WOW! There were so many beautiful and varied orchids—all colours, shapes, and sizes. Before this, I had no idea of the diversity of tropical orchids.

After that trip, my partner bought me an orchid when he was on one of his nursery tours looking at rhododendrons (his passion). It was a phalaenopsis hybrid named Daniella. When it finished blooming, I dutifully watered it (I thought the leaves looked nice) and about a year later, it rebloomed for me.

I was hooked!

I was no longer afraid of growing orchids, and over the next few months, another phal or two, a couple of paphs, and a Den nobile slowly made their way into our house. One day, I went to take some photos at an orchid display at Bloedel Conservatory and met Margaret Prat, who talked to me about the orchids on display, showed me some scented ones (I didn't know orchids could be scented!), and told me about the Vancouver Orchid Society. About a year later, I finally got around to going to one of the VOS meetings and ended up joining the society that night. Joining the VOS really fuelled my addiction by allowing me to learn more about orchids and giving me opportunities to buy interesting orchids that aren't sold in the local stores. Since then, my collection has grown exponentially, and now I have well over 100 plants (and still buying). They are in my living room, my office, and on my bedroom balcony.

If only I had more space!


