Thanks also to all who volunteered for the GardenWorks "Orchid Obsessions" weekend on February 9th and February10th.

For those of us who have orchids that are only beginning to crawl out of their pots, producing new sprouts and are rambling along in mid-air, they will require repotting or dividing before they get out of hand. Repotting is an unavoidable disruption to the potted orchid. Inevitably some injury is going to result in the process of replacing old medium with new. Minor root damage in repotting is of little consequence when compared to the alternative of major root decay if a change of medium is delayed. With new root growth orchids overcome any damage which may occur with repotting. For this reason it is very important to repot at a time when the orchid is just beginning new root growth. Thanks to Calvin Wong, those of us who attended culture class know that tea made from willow stimulates root growth.

We encourage all members to take advantage of the monthly culture class event. Next month Eugene will be speaking on his journey to success and his experiences with mistakes. It promises to be helpful for all orchid lovers, not to be missed.

Your orchid society depends heavily on volunteers as you can imagine, <u>so as an orchid community we need to</u> <u>pitch in and help.</u> We need volunteers to lend a helping hand in making your March show one of the best. Taiwan International Orchid Show 2019

The first Orchid event is Taiwan International Orchid Show (TIOS) 2019 which will be held on Mar. 2nd, 2019 to Mar. 11th, 2019 at Taiwan Orchid Plantation in Tainan, Taiwan. This event will be held in every March and it has already last for more than 10 years. The subject of the Show will be 'Orchid land', which means that explore orchids in the island. World Orchid Conference 2020

The second Orchid event is World Orchid Conference (WOC) 2020 which will be held on Mar. 9th, 2020 to Mar. 29th, 2020 at Waipu Expo Site in Taichung, Taiwan. In the 23rd WOC, Taiwan hopes to present the results of the orchid conservation initiative, make an orchid check list as the database of orchid collection, invite famous research experts abroad as speakers, encourage the youths who take part in the orchid research to join WOC, and conclude the covenant with global orchid associations to spread out the information.
