While the opportunity to enjoy more light and heat is beneficial, keep in mind factors that could do some damage to the orchids: sunburn, dehydration and pests. Make sure to provide protection from the direct sun rays by placing them under trees, on an eastern side of the building or using shade cloth.

Water your outdoor orchids more often and inspect them for signs of insect damage. Placing slug traps will help to stop these unwanted pests to make their way indoors at the end of the season.

I hope you had a chance to attend Margaret's Open house, enjoy all the lovely local orchids and the greenhouse. It's a great opportunity to get more orchids, socialize and learn from Margaret and Wayne, they have decades of experience growing orchids and both love to share their knowledge.














