President's Message

May is already here and, with the warmer weather, some of us will be moving a few orchids.

Taking care of a few precautions will keep our orchids safe. Frequent inspections looking for pests, use of plastic domes, shade clothes and analyzing the weather conditions at the chosen location are ways to increase success while growing outdoors.

For the ones that grow indoors, the same windowsill that had adequate sunlight in the winter, it could expose the leaves to excessive sunlight. Keeping an eye on the conditions is key to survive the changing of the seasons.

My Guarianthes are already developing new shoots, sensing the warmer temperatures and brighter light. They monopolize the front row of the south facing window and I am anxiously waiting to see if the blacken sheaths from last Fall will bloom in the following months. My greatest challenge is keeping high humidity levels on the growing area.

I tried last year with a 10 gallon fish tank covered with clear plastic film and the Vanilla and Vandas are loving it: thick new roots are a joy to watch. Placing the plastic pots inside clay pots on a saucer with water also increases humidity and cools the roots of orchids that require a cooler environment.

Make sure you attend our May's Culture Class, to learn from our Paphiopedilum's master grower, Lori Barrington, as she shares her secrets on growing her prized orchids. The class is an in-person meeting.




